

Annual Community Requirements

Potential New Members

Potential New Members (PNMs) across all councils must do the following to receive a bid (IFC & PHA) or invitation for recruitment participation (MGC & NPHC):

- Have a **minimum 2.5 college or high school cumulative GPA**
- Complete the **Potential New Member Interest and Disclosure Form**
- Complete the **FSL 101 Module**
- Complete the **Hazing Education and Prevention (HEP) Module***

*IFC and PHA PNMs joining during the Spring formal recruitment cycles do not need to complete the HEP module as the content will be discussed during PNM Orientation.

New Members (Fall 2025 and Spring 2026)

New Members across all councils must complete the following requirements to be in good standing with Fraternity and Sorority Life:

- Attend **FSL's New Member Retreat** (10 am-4 pm)
 - **Fall 2025** New Members: Saturday, November 8, 2025
 - **Spring 2026** New Members: Sunday, March 29, 2026
- Attend a one-hour, in-person **Hazing Education and Prevention Spring Extension** session in the Spring 2026 semester (7 pm, Continental Ballroom): 1/21, 3/5, 3/20 (USC 309), 4/1, 4/10, or 4/16

Annual Community Requirements

General Members

General Members across all councils must complete the following requirements to remain in good standing with Fraternity and Sorority Life:

- Complete the **Hazing Education and Prevention Module** by October 1, 2025
- Attend a one-hour, in-person **Hazing Education and Prevention Spring Extension** session in the Spring 2026 semester (7 pm, Continental Ballroom): 1/21, 3/5, 3/20 (USC 309), 4/1, 4/10, or 4/16

Officers

All officers across all **chapters** and **councils** must complete the following requirements to remain in good standing with Fraternity and Sorority Life:

- Complete all **General Member requirements**

Presidents

All council and chapter presidents must:

- Attend **recurring meetings with FSL Staff Advisor**
- Attend one of two **Student Org Summit** officer training dates (or have another officer attend in your place, if necessary): September 6, 2025, or September 7, 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Attend monthly **President's Meetings**
- Ensure that your chapter completes the **Revolution Accreditation Program (RAP)** and **Student Organization Re-Registration** requirements on time

Officers continued

Vice Presidents

All chapter and council vice presidents must attend one of two Student Org Summit officer training dates (or have another officer attend in your place, if necessary):

- September 6, 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., **or**;
- September 7, 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Financial Officers

All chapter and council financial officers must attend one of two Student Org Summit officer training dates (you can depart after the Policy and Finance session):

- September 6, 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., **or**;
- September 7, 2025, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

New Member Educators

All chapter New Member Educators must attend at least one Community Chapter each semester that falls under the RAP **Membership Development** Priority Area:

- October 14 at 7 pm in Continental Ballroom
- November 11 at 7 pm in Continental Ballroom
- February 26 at 7 pm in USC 309
- March 26 at 7 pm in Continental Ballroom

Risk Managers

All chapter Risk Managers must attend at least one Community Chapter each semester that falls under the RAP **Harm Reduction** Priority Area:

- September 11 at 7 pm in Continental Ballroom
- September 29 at 7 pm in Continental Ballroom
- January 27 at 7 pm in Continental Ballroom
- February 2 at 7 pm in Continental Ballroom

Annual Community Requirements

Officers continued

House Managers*

All FSL House Managers must complete the following requirements so that they, and their chapter properties, remain in good standing with Fraternity and Sorority Life & Campus Living and Residential Education:

- Complete **weekly reflections**
- Conduct biweekly **property walkthroughs**
- Attend monthly **House Manager meetings**
- Host monthly **house meetings**
- Put on at least **two housing programs** (based on targeted program areas) each semester
- Provide semesterly **roster updates** to FSL Housing
- **Report relevant incidents** as a Campus Security Authority (CSA)
- Attend pre-semester **House Manager Trainings**
- Maintain **timely communication** with FSL Housing team

Advisors

All chapter advisors must complete the following requirements to remain in good standing with Fraternity and Sorority Life:

- Attend monthly **Advisor's Meetings**
- Attend a one-hour, in-person **Hazing Education and Prevention Spring Extension** session in the Spring 2026 semester (7 pm, Continental Ballroom): 1/21, 3/5, 3/20 (USC 309), 4/1, 4/10, or 4/16
